



It is very important to take clear photos of the grass flower head to help both identify the grass and indicate pollen production stage. Use something for contrast behind the flower if needed.



It is also important to take clear photos of the grass plant itself (size etc are important species characteristics). Photos of the area around the observation point are also helpful.

If you use a smartphone, explore camera modes e.g. 'pro' or 'portrait' to increase the quality of photos taken.



Try to avoid uploading blurry photos and photos which do not clearly indicate what to look at. Observations of grass without a flower can be extremely difficult to identify.
